

AN ORDINANCE authorizing the City of Joplin to enter into a five year lease agreement with VGM Financial Services, a division of TCF National Bank, for the leasing of golf course equipment to the City of Joplin in the amount of One Hundred Thirty Nine Thousand Eight Hundred Thirty One and 00/100 Dollars (\$139,831.00); authorizing the City Manager to execute said Agreement by and on behalf of the City of Joplin, Missouri; and containing an emergency clause.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF JOPLIN, MISSOURI, as follows:

Section 1. That the Agreement by and between the City of Joplin, Missouri, and VGM Financial Services, a division of TCF National Bank, leasing golf course equipment to the City of Joplin, a copy of said Agreement being attached hereto and incorporated herein as Exhibit "1", be and the same is hereby, approved in the same or substantially similar form.

Section 2. That the competitive bidding element has already been conducted by a different public agency, the National Joint Powers Alliance ("NJPA") Cooperative. The State of Missouri recognizes the NJPA as an alternative for local and state agencies. Therefore, the City Council deems that competitive bidding for the agreement with VGM Financial Services, a division of TCF National Bank, to be inappropriate in this circumstance.

Section 3. That the City Manager of the City of Joplin is hereby authorized and directed to execute said Agreement by and on behalf of the City of Joplin, Missouri.

Section 4. That the City hereby declares that this Ordinance, dealing with a general appropriation, is considered an emergency within the meaning of Section 2.12(4) of the Home Rule Charter of the City of Joplin, Missouri, and, as such, this Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage. Specifically, this Agreement is a general appropriation ordinance.
