Voting in favor were Mrs. Lewis, Mr. Glaze, Dr. Rosenberg, Mayor Seibert and Mr. Shaw, 5-1-3, with Mr. Scearce voting no.

State Auditor's office to give a follow-up report.

Paul Harper and Pam Allison from the State Auditor's briefed Council with a follow-up summary outlining findings from their offices including the open records law and since the initial audit report findings show that minutes of work sessions and closed sessions had been kept and that items discussed were allowed. She further noted the city's bidding procedure and that the city is getting ready to implement a change order policy. When the process of the hiring of the city master developer was discussed the city manager and the Mayor both agreed there were no plans for a master developer at this time or in the near future but if so needed proper bidding/consulting would be undertaken before a master developer would be hired.
