INTRODUCTION:

This Council Bill approves an Agreement with Allied Services for the City to administer the residential trash billing and collections on behalf of the residential trash provider.

DISCUSSION:

The City of Joplin currently administers the residential trash billing and collections with the sewer billing on behalf of the residential trash provider. The City recently executed a new Solid Waste Collection Services Agreement effective April 1, 2016. As a result of the new services agreement, the Trash Billing and Collections Agreement is being updated and renewed. Essentially the Agreement mirrors the existing agreement, except this Agreement sets forth the parameters for billing and collecting the new curbside recycling option. Residents will sign up or terminate the recycling option directly with Allied Services. Allied will correspond with Finance staff for billing purposes.

The City will continue to assess an administrative fee of \$0.55 cents per bill for this billing and collection service.

RECOMMENDATION:

City Staff recommends this Council Bill be approved on an emergency basis.
