

COUNCIL BILL NO. 2016-605

ORDINANCE NO.

AN ORDINANCE approving a contract with Crossland Construction for the Public Safety Training Facility project in the amount of Four Million, Seven Hundred Seventy-Eight Thousand Dollars. (\$ 4,778,000.00) in the City of Joplin, Missouri; providing how the cost shall be made and levied and containing an emergency clause.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF JOPLIN, MISSOURI, as follows:

Section 1. That the contract be awarded to Crossland Construction for the Public Safety Training Facility Project in the amount of Four-Million, Seven Hundred Seventy-Eight Thousand Dollars. (\$ 4,778,000.00) in the City of Joplin, Missouri.

Section 2. That the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to execute said Contract by and on behalf of the City of Joplin, Missouri in the same or substantially similar form.

Section 3. That this Ordinance, dealing generally with public safety and a current expenditure of the City of Joplin, is an emergency within the meaning of Section 2.12(1)(6)(3) of the Home Rule Charter of the City of Joplin, Missouri, and, as such, shall be in full force and effect immediately from and after its adoption and approval. Specifically this ordinance deals with a construction project that is time sensitive and needs to be started in the optimal construction season.
