CALL TO ORDER

The regular meeting for the Joplin City Council was called to order at 6:00 p.m. by Mayor Michael Seibert.

INVOCATION - read by City Clerk Barbara Hogelin

Offered as a 14-week program, the Academy is FREE of charge and provides an interactive, behind-the-scenes program taught by police officers. The classes are every Thursday evening starting February 2nd from 6:30 to 9 p.m. The Citizens Academy ends on May 4th with a graduation ceremony and dinner.
