Semi-annual health insurance report from Segal

Before Council heard from the Segal representatives, Leslie updated the council on the Health Nuts committee (the employees' health committee). She introduced Dan Pekarek as the new co-chair of this committee. Dan will be overseeing the wellness part of the committee. His role as co-chair is to focus on healthy behaviors such as diet and exercise.

Leslie is the other co-chair and her focus will be on the insurance part. She introduced the Segal reps: Kim from Detroit and Dorothy from Chicago.

Kim reviewed the report the council received before the meeting. The 2017 financial statement showed that 2017 was an excellent year in terms of no large claims and expenses being down. There was a total \$ 5.4 million in expenses, which averages about \$ 452,000 per month. There were additional contributions of \$464,000 to the reserves.

The reserve statement that was provided last year showed the appropriate level of \$2.8 million. We're at \$2.6 million. Overall, it was a good report and Leslie stated that part of this was attributed to the Health Nut's committee's campaign to raise awareness regarding the importance of health; and the fact that a lot of our costs are way below national averages because of the discounts we receive from Freeman.

Boards/Commissions Appointments/Reappointments:

Mr. Stinnett nominated Bill Scarce to the Joplin Redevelopment Corp. The vote was 8-0-1.

Mr. West nominated Andy Perigo to the Joplin Redevelopment Corp. The vote was 8-0-1.

Mr. West nominated Kevin Welch to the Joplin Sports Authority; but then rescinded his nomination.

Mr. Stinnett nominated Forrest Reed to the Joplin Sports Authority. The vote was 8-0-1.

Mrs. Reid Adams nominated Paul Teverow to the Parks & Rec Board. The vote was 8-0-1.

Mr. West nominated Rodney McCullough to the TIF commission. The voter was 8-0-1.
