- Save time & money with data driven decisions.
- Increase civic engagement by involving citizens in community dialogue.

The SeeClickFix program can collect, manage, and route requests seamlessly through your work order flow with easy-to-use web forms and mobile apps, from the moment they're opened to the moment they're closed.

After the demonstration and discussion period, the consensus of the Council was to move forward with the process to adopt SeeClickFix. The item will be presented at a future formal council meeting.

Mr. Anselm informed the Council that the laptop in the council chambers was recently updated and may cause some distortion issues with the monitors at the council members' seats on the dais.
