Approval of Minutes

Discussion of Memorial Hall Election

Prior to the meeting, Chairman Harrington asked each committee member to bring a list of the top 10 things the renovation of Memorial Hall would bring to Joplin. During the meeting, he asked committee members to take turns sharing their lists with the group.

Joplin Chamber of Commerce Vice-President Tonya Sprenkle reviewed the plans for campaign signage. The current plan is to design and purchase 20 large signs and 200 yard signs to distribute around the city. Committee member Shelly Kraft is keeping a master list of the addresses as to where to put the Chamber signage and asked the committee to send her signage locations to add to the list. The signs will be put out approximately 3 weeks prior to the April 5th election. The American Legion is also developing their own campaign signs and billboards to distribute.

Chairman Harrington asked the committee to share the comments and questions they are hearing from the community about the initiative and to discuss how to best answer these.

Public Information Officer Lynn Onstot updated the progress of the City's educational efforts. The website will be updated tentatively by February 24 and bids are being accepted on the design of a one-page postcard handout.
