**CALL TO ORDER**

The regular meeting of the May 4, 2022, Proposition Action Implementation and Oversight Committee was called to order by Chair Rob O'Brian at 4:05 p.m.


**Approval of Meeting Minutes:** Gary motioned to approve the previous month's meeting minutes. Mike seconded the motion. Committee unanimously approved minutes.

**NEW BUSINESS**

**Discussion of Public Safety Tax:** City Manager presented the proposed property tax initiative, describing the impact on the use tax proceeds and proposed action plans under the public safety portion. Chief Rowland provided an overview of the action plans that will not be covered by the new property tax, including traffic safety staffing positions. Chief also offered clarification on how Use Tax dollars would contribute to staffing/visibility and provided an overview of current staffing levels. Committee discussed public safety in regard to how it affects economic development. Staff answered questions from Committee regarding the new proposed tax. Jhan made motion to approve that an estimated \$350,000 of Use Tax Dollars allocated towards the action plans be used to offset the property tax proposal and that it is still achieving action plan goals laid out by the committee. The remainder of the funds would be used to address the action plans not covered by the property tax. Gary seconded the motion. The committee passed the motion unanimously.

With no further business, the committee adjourned at 4:59.
