MEETING CALLED TO ORDER:

Paul Teverow called the regular meeting to order.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES:

Brad McIntyre made a motion to approve the minutes with a second by Kreg Selvey.

OLD BUSINESS:

Paul said the 100th anniversary for our Golf Course is coming up. We will be having a golf tournament on June 25th and on the actual anniversary June 29th we will be having a celebration. He said that Daryn and Patrick Tuttle have done well on getting sponsorships. He said that Chris Wiseman from the Museum has also been helping with articles for the Joplin Globe on the history of the Golf Course.

Linda Teeter and a group of volunteers will start the prep work at Spiva Park tomorrow. They have reached out to Keller Williams, and they will be having a volunteer day in the park on May 12. Paul said he has had a lot of people tell him that they didn't realize that was a City Park they thought it was part of the Joplin Globe.

NEW BUSINESS:

He also stated that as of now we will be opening the Schifferdecker lap pool to the public. It will still offer 2 slides, rock wall, diving boards, and the

zero-depth entry for the younger kids. We have two more lifeguard trainings and if everyone passes, we will have 37 lifeguards. Last year we had 68 lifeguards. We will open Cunningham Pool for swim lessons and pool parties. Ewert Pool will not open.

Paul told the board that we opened the Landscaping RFP. We only received one bid and it was from Simpson Lawn Care. They are located out of Webb City. The RFP was writing so we can choose which projects they will work on. After discussion with our parks supervisor Simpson Lawn Care will be doing seven main parks. They will be weeding and removing trash from the park entrance flower beds, the flower beds and hanging flowerpots on Main Street from 15th Street to 32nd Street. Paul also mentioned that they would be starting this next week and will continue through October.

Paul said that MSSU reached out to him about bringing back the 4th of July celebration. They will be opening the stadium again to the public.

He also stated that the RFP for the Museum Strategic Study was opened. We had two companies bid and we will be reviewing and interviewing both companies. The companies that bid were Pacific Coast Conservation out of Denver, Colorado, and Peckham Guyton Albers and Viets, INC out of St. Louis, Missouri.

Paul mentioned next meeting, we will need to select new Chair and Vice-Chair.
